I/We will:

- support my child’s learning by sharing knowledge and understanding of my child

- attend parents’ evenings, reviews and other school events
- name all clothing that comes into school
- provide spare clothing every day
- provide the school with up to date emergency telephone numbers and, where possible, an email address
- inform the school of any changes at home which may impact upon my child’s behaviour in school
- to be able to collect my child during the school day, if requested by the school, for reasons of sudden illness or in the event of your local authority transport being unable to take your child home
